Learning must travel

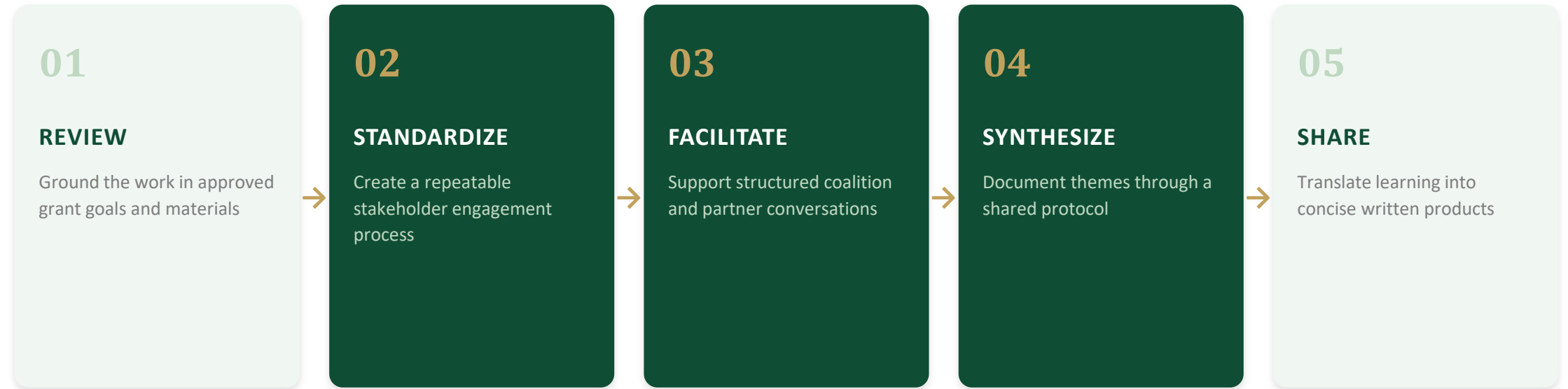
Insights need usable formats for partners and stakeholders.
